LOFT is a five-day (four-night) program designed for participants to develop skills in individual leadership, teamwork, understanding group dynamics and communication, public speaking, and self-advocacy. The program provides a supportive and structured environment in which participants increase their self-confidence and their understanding of their own strengths and abilities through activities designed to challenge them to work outside of their comfort zone.
